#### 13. Trustees:

# 14. Skate Park:

Meeting aired some concerns as to where this would be located. Will there be a full public consultation? Discussion followed re planning, consultations etc. Agreed that we would remain vigilant to progress being made and respond, as and when appropriate.

# 15. Village Hall Managers report:

Kaye confirmed that the pump has been replaced on one of the boilers. Full service of water heaters, boilers etc. and gas safety certificate issued.

The corridors, toilets and snug have been decorated during the Christmas period.

#### 16. Bookings Manager:

Mike confirmed that bookings for children's parties are increasing. Enquiries were made for Christmas Parties and New Year's Eve parties were made, however due to decorators, unable to accommodate.

#### 17. Santa's Sleigh:

Safety issues raised – on one evening the sleigh became detached from the tow vehicle – this needs to be added into the risk assessment. Due to busy roads, do we need to consider having a traffic marshal? Volunteers for Thursday evening – Sandra struggled to find enough people and will probably be in same position this time.

Agreed by meeting that this will be put on Agenda for September meeting and discussed further.

#### 18. Any other business:

In theory the meeting agreed that as this is a community building, providing we were happy with the type of event we were in favour of the request.
